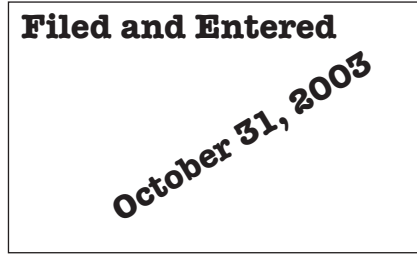

19 Defendant, Shawn Brunetti appeals his/her conviction on the grounds that it was
20 obtained in violation of his/her Second and Fourteen Amendment rights.

21 **Facts**

22 Shawn Brunetti acknowledges ownership of an AK-47 rifle which is not registered as
23 required by California Penal Code §12280.

24 **Legal Argument**

25 The California registration and assault ban statutes (PC §12280) are unconstitutional
26 as they violate Shawn Brunetti's individual right to bear arms as protected by the Second
27 Amendment. In the case of *Printz vs U. S.* 117 S.Ct. 2365 (1997) Justice Thomas indicates "the
28 right to keep and bear arms is, as the Amendment's text suggests, a personal right."

Wherefore, Appellant prays that his/her conviction be reversed.
